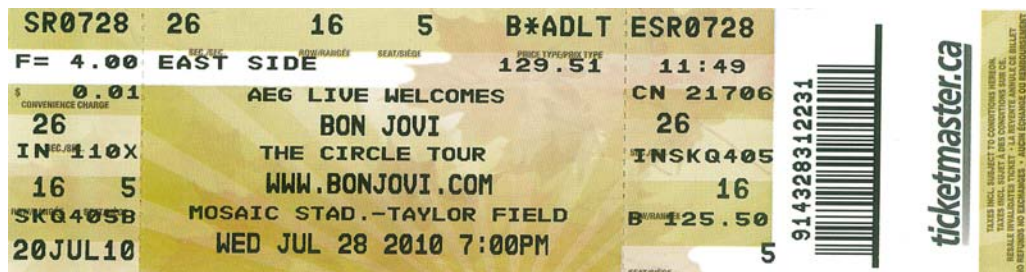

## Show times

Doors: 5:30 pm  
Contest Winner: 6:00pm – 6:30 pm  
Kid Rock: 7:00 pm – 8:00 pm  
Bon Jovi 8:30 pm – end of show

## Entry to the venue

All ticket holders have a specific Gate Entry. Please note the section on your ticket and refer to the map to find the closest gate of entry to your seat. This will ensure quick entry and help to avoid long lineups. Grandstand ticket holder can enter 'West' or 'East' gate as noted on the ticket. All patrons with floor seats in Sections B, C, or D can enter through the 'North' gate, Floor patrons with seats in Section A can enter through the 'South' Gate.



A thorough pat-down will take place at entry gates, if you can, avoid bringing a bag with you, as this will help with a speedy entry.

## Picking Up Your Tickets at the Venue

If you do not have your tickets yet, we encourage you to pick them up in advance of the show. This will help alleviate line ups at the box office will call entry points and make your concert going experience more enjoyable. In advance, tickets can be picked up at the Brandt Centre Box Office. You will require your photo ID and the credit card used to buy the ticket.

There is one (1) box office at Mosaic Stadium located at the Southwest corner.

## Seating

This is a Reserved Seat show. Everyone has an assigned seat. No general admission seating on the floor or in the stands. For safety reasons you will be required to stay in your seat during the show. Standing in the aisles will not be permitted.

## Parking

Parking at the Stadium is very limited. We encourage you to take the "Safe Ride to the Concert" City Transit service sponsored by SGI or car pool.

Parking is available for \$6 at the Regina Sportplex - access off of Elphinstone St via Saskatchewan Drive, as well as in the lots along North Railway Street - access off Albert Street and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue, or Elphinstone and North Railway Street via Saskatchewan Drive.

Parking is also available for \$5 in the Armouries lot (1600 Block of Elphinstone Street) - access off of Elphinstone Street via Dewdney Ave.

Additional parking is available at Evraz Place.

## Safe Ride Program

We encourage patrons to utilize the Safe Ride to the Concert City Transit Service sponsored by SGI. City of Regina buses will depart from the Victoria Square Mall, Southland Mall, Northgate Mall and Normanview Mall beginning at 5:00 pm and will leave at 15 minute intervals until the scheduled show time.

## Local Traffic

Parking enforcement will start at 3 p.m. and continue until the end of the concert around 11 p.m. in the following areas:

Barricades will be set up at the following intersections and only vehicles with resident parking permits will be allowed to enter the restricted area.

- 9th Avenue, east of Angus Street to west of Montague Street
- 9th Avenue west of Elphinstone Street to alley east of Argyle Street
- Angus Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th & 10th Avenue
- Rae Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th & 10th Avenue
- Retallack Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th & 10th Avenue
- Robinson Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th Avenue
- Cameron Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th Avenue
- Garnet Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th and 10th Avenue
- Athol Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th & 10th Avenue
- Montague Street at Dewdney Avenue, 9th & 10th Avenue

**NOTE:** Elphinstone Street from Dewdney Avenue to Saskatchewan Drive will be closed to through traffic after 9:00 PM.

There will be no vehicular traffic allowed from East to West on 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> Avenue between Elphinstone Street to Albert Street and North to South from the North Railway Street to Dewdney Avenue.

### **Special exceptions**

Working animals will be allowed on site (i.e. guide dogs).

Designated seating areas for any patron requiring wheel chair or special seating consideration are paid tickets only through Ticketmaster.

### **Food & Beverages**

There will be a wide variety of food and beverage options on site. Purchases will be made at point of sale. Bar Sales will close shortly after Bon Jovi takes the stage.

### **ATM**

Most Concession and Beverage locations are Cash Only. For your convenience there will be many ATM machines located in the Stadium.

### **Taxi stands**

Designated drop off and pick up locations are the Regina Sportplex (Fieldhouse) as well as Dewdney Ave at Angus Street.

### **Weather**

As this is an outdoor venue – please be prepared for the weather. The show will happen – rain or shine! We suggest bringing a rain coat or poncho and layer up. We encourage you to leave the umbrella at home so everyone will be able to see the band without obstructions.
