



IPSCO Place encompasses 102 acres, including more than one million square feet of indoor space, between Lewvan Drive Elphinstone Street in the heart of Regina.

IPSCO Place is an economic engine with a \$66 million dollar annual impact in our community. IPSCO Place touches a broad range of people with over 70% of those within an 80 km radius visiting at least once per year.

Over 1 million people pass through the gates of IPSCO Place each year.

Events at IPSCO Place provide local, regional and national media exposure, including 15 days of live national event coverage this year alone.

FACILITIES AT IPSCO PLACE

Three key facilities drive much of the traffic at IPSCO Place and play a key role in hosting on-going and special events.



This facility is the primary spectator sports and entertainment facility in southern Saskatchewan, with more than 600,000 people passing through its doors for Regina Pats hockey, Canadian Western Agribition and concerts such as Cher and Avril Lavigne.

In the last six months, this facility has hosted Nickelback, Hilary Duff, Black Eyed Peas, the Harlem Globetrotters and Canada's biggest party, the Tim Horton's Brier.



Opened in June, 2005, this state-of-the-art 90,000 square foot facility is a multi-purpose turf sport and exhibit facility with the capacity to host up to 7,000 people for special events, in air conditioned comfort.

This facility hosts more than 300 event days a year, with an annual traffic flow of more than 700,000 people.



The newly remodeled and expanded Queensbury Convention Centre is able to accommodate groups of up to 2,000 for conventions, meetings and banquets.

Every year the Queensbury plays host to several high profile events such as the Saskatchewan Roughriders' Plaza of Honor Dinner and the Saskatchewan Chamber of Commerce ABEX Awards.
