Iceville presented by SaskTel Back for Another Season

Regina, Saskatchewan – The Regina Exhibition Association Limited (REAL) is excited to announce Iceville presented by SaskTel is back for another season at Mosaic Stadium.

Registration opens at noon today, (Friday, Dec. 17, 2021). The first available ice time is 12 p.m. on Dec. 31, 2021. To book ice time go to www.iceville.ca. Ice sessions are available in one hour blocks. The ice capacity per hour is 215 skaters.

Iceville runs from Dec. 31 2021 to Feb. 3, 2022. There is a cost of \$5 per person to skate, which includes taxes and fees. Iceville is also open during Frost @ REAL which is from Feb. 4 – 13. During this time, access to the ice is available with a Frost Pass, subject to capacity. The rink is open from noon – 10 p.m. Monday to Friday and 10 a.m. – 10 p.m. on weekends. Music is supplied by media partner Play 92.1 F.M.

“We are so excited to bring back Saskatchewan’s largest ice surface,” said Tim Reid, President and CEO of REAL. “Iceville is an experience unlike any other. The memories created on this special ice surface for friends and families were incredible. We look forward to people having the chance to make even more memories this season.”

To commemorate the second season of Iceville which opens on New Year’s Eve Day, there will be a special skate from 9 – 10 p.m. which will conclude with an incredible fireworks display taking place behind the Maxtron. Be sure to join us for this special celebration. REAL has expanded ice capacity for this special event. The price remains the same for skating. The public is invited to come down to Mosaic Stadium, for free, if they just want to watch the fireworks from the stands.

While at Iceville, explore the warm and inviting environment inside the SGI Chalet (Harvard Lounge) before or after skating. The lounge is being converted into a ski chalet with sofas, chairs, carpets and blankets to name a few of the amenities. There is grab and go food and drinks during the day and a special chalet menu of food and drinks, including some signature cocktails, in the evening.

Fridays at Iceville are extra special in January with Dinner and a Skate in the AGT Lounge. From 6 - 9 p.m., REAL’s Chef Chaminda will have a special menu served in one of Regina’s prime locations, the AGT Lounge. There will be entertainment as well. The price is \$35 and includes skating. Dinner and a Skate can be booked online.

For anyone who doesn’t have skates but wants to experience Iceville, REAL’s partner, Extreme Hockey is offering skate rentals, with a wide range of sizes, inside the Chalet. The cost to rent skates is \$6 a pair, taxes included. For anyone who’s skates need a new edge, Extreme Hockey will also have sharpening available on site.

Private skates times are also available at a cost of \$300 per hour. They can be booked at Iceville.ca.

Everyone is reminded that due to public health orders in effect everyone coming to Iceville, 12 yrs and older must provide their proof of vaccination or a negative COVID test when checking in. The negative COVID test must have been done within 72 hours of the designated skate time. In addition, masks must be worn while indoors at Mosaic Stadium. They can be removed while eating or drinking but you must be seated while doing so.
